विषय/Subject: To consider inclusion of soil test reports before and after the crop season under PGS India system -reg

Sir/Madam,

As a follow up to the 5<sup>th</sup> NEC meeting of PGS India programme held on 12.04.2023, it is to inform that NEC decided to include soil testing as per Soil Health Card (SHC) scheme mechanism approved by ICAR/State/Central Govt/ Ministry.

You all may be aware that there is already a provision existing in PGS India webportal under RC domain to upload soil test reports (see Annexure). Therefore, all authorized RCs are requested to ensure regular uploading of data in PGS India webportal under RC domain. Atleast 5-10% of such total soil test reports tested as per SHC framework may be uploaded.

Note that the activities of RC will be evaluated before renewal, so ensure authentic and adequate data to be uploaded in the PGS India webportal.
